

Summary 2021 Activities

Road Maintenance

- Trenches completed along Carriage Drive north end
- More recycled asphalt used in 2021 on trouble spots
- Newer road base continued that holds up much better under normal conditions
 - Some muddy issues due higher clay content
- New Road signs installed
- A few roads had increased road base added (build up and crown)
- Regular trouble spots covered
- Homeowners: Driveway culvert clean outs
- Responded to numerous resident questions/issues

Snow Removal

- Same snow removal vendor. Challenging start to season.
 - Missed roadway, drifting, other. Generally good post slow start.

Traffic volumes, speed, patterns, safety

- We have the results from the classifier we placed on Carriage Dr north of Wildlife Ln. The 85th percentile speed was about 10 MPH over the posted speed limit of 25 MPH. The average speed was about 7 MPH over the posted speed of 25 MPH. This data does represent there is a speeding issue on Carriage Dr.
- Various alternatives have been considered (bumps, swales, stop signs)
 - Approved alternative will be Radar Speed Signage....others:
 - Ex. "Speedbumps would require 65% of residents to approve"
 - Ex. Stop sign(s) require specific volumes and intersection needs

2022 Planned/In Process

Road Maintenance

- Asphalt patching and Chip seal to asphalt roads
- Aspen/Fish Creek repairs due vehicle damage (post/culvert)
- Pine Meadow trench work
- Trench work, south Carriage Drive
- Raising and crowning of deteriorating roadways in subdivision.
- Continued utilization of re-cycled asphalt in some key trouble spots
- Regular road grading and dust suppression application
- Approved Radar signs on Carriage Drive to mitigate speeding issue
- Moving some speed signage due poor placement

Snow Removal

Currently no changes planned as per county

Future

- Overlay of Carriage Drive. The overlay would consist of patching failing areas, a 2" overlay, and adding gravel to the edges of the road.
- Issue: Town/Water Dept. intends to replace subdivision key water main which currently runs under the length of Carriage Drive. Project was originally slated to be done in X years but due federally mandated water department repairs we wont see that main replaced for Y years.
